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3. Demonstrate an accurate assessment of a child with abdominal pain and escalate findings appropriately
4. Post operatively, assess the child hollistically initially assessing the A, B, C, D, E and continuing with
 - Pain assessment, using age appropriate pain tools, effective pain management and reassessment
 - Perform wound care using aseptic technique, liaise with the MDT adopting best dressing options
 - Fluid balance record is adhered to recognising signs of dehydration, overload and sepsis
5. Follow the prescribed plan of care for the child with mental health concerns
