## Clinical Learning Outcomes Stage 1

#### **Direct Supervision**

By the end of this placement

- 1. Recall and implement the key principles of infant safety, including ensuring cot sides are up, appropriate infant positioning, and safe sleep practices.
- 2. Understand the importance of & how to perform & document patient 'safety checks'
- **3.** Observe/participate in the provision of intimate care needs for an infant under supervision, including bath, bed bath, nappy care, umbilical care, eye & oral care.
- **4.** Bottle feed an infant & discuss the key principles of bottle feeding, breastfeeding, enteral feeding, and the basic feed requirements/types for infants.
- **5.** Gain confidence in communicating with parents/ infants in a compassionate, child friendly & professional manner.
- **6.** Observe/participate in the assessment of infants using PEWS under supervision

## Clinical Learning Outcomes Stage 2 & 3

## **Indirect Supervision**

By the end of this placement

- 1. Participate in maintaining infant safety, eg. ensuring cotsides up, appropriate infant positioning, perform & document patient 'safety checks'
- 2. : Practice the safe management of nursing care for infants with feeding tubes under supervision, including the preparation, administration, and monitoring of enteral feeds.
- 3. Make a plan of care with the guidance of your preceptor
- 4. Participate in maintaining hygiene needs for an infant: bath, bed bath, nappy care, umbilical care, eye & oral care
- 5. Participate in obtaining blood sugar readings from infants under supervision and demonstrate awareness and implications of fasting times in an infant setting.
- 6. Observe /participate with preceptor in pre/post op care of patient

## Clinical Learning Outcomes Stage 4

## **Distant Supervision**

By the end of this placement

- 1. Participate in the care of infants requiring enteral feeding, eg. nasogastric/naso jejunal/PEG
- 2. Participate in the nursing assessment & care of an infant requiring respiratory support eg.oxygen therapy, Airvo
- 3. Calculate the feeding and IV fluid requirements for an infant of a given weight.
- 4. Complete a pre-anaesthetic theatre check list
