

Delivery of Expressed Breast Milk (EBM) Safety Checks Algorithm

MILK SAFETY CHECKS A

- First checker must a registered nurse
- Second checker can be a:
 - o Parent or
 - o Registered Nurse or
 - o Student Nurse (Intern/PRCNS) or
 - o Health & Social Care Professional

ORDER OF USE OF EBM

- 1. Colostrum day 1-5
- 2. Fresh EBM
- 3. Frozen EBM using oldest date first

When removing EBM from the fridge for patient, please follow these instructions



The 2 checkers must check the following:

- Patient Name
- o HcRN
- o Date of birth
- o Date & time milk was expressed or
- o Date & time if milk decanted / defrosted
- o ID band at bedside



Fortification/ additions: 2 checkers must ensure details on patient's diet sheet match directions on sachet/ label on bottle containing product from formula room



The 2 checkers perform safety checks at the patient's bedside



The 2 checkers must date & sign the delivery of EBM safety checks sheet
