


MIC-KEY DISCHARGE CHECKLIST

Please tick	Yes	Date	Sign
Re-iterate normal skin care as per PEG tube:			
Twice daily cleaning and drying with mild soap and water: use a non-shedding non-sterile disposable wash cloth			
Demonstrate daily rotation of the tube 360°			
Identify component parts of tube : Size/length Fr/cm			
Demonstrate filling balloon:			
Done weekly/5mls cool boiled water			
Give spare luer lock syringes for use at home			
Practice attaching and detaching extension set			
Wash and air dry/change as required			
Clean feeding port with cotton bud if needed			
Give parents a copy of Mic-Key (Kimberley-Clarke) Booklet (from Mic-Key pack)			
Give parents a copy of Mic-Key Advice for Parents/guardians caring for an infant/child with a mic-key Button			
Give spare feeding extension set 0126-12 or 0321-12			
Give copy of prescription for spare Mic-Key button and extension sets			
If tube falls out before parents have received teaching/practice in routine changes: Advise parents to attend local A/E to check correct placement. If no tube is in place they must attend local A/E within 2-3 hrs.			
Arrange CNS follow up for teaching tube changes:
